



Summer Credit Courses 2021:

SPH4U – Grade 12 Physics (university preparation)

- Offered to students entering Grade 12 next year.
- Prerequisite SPH3U.
- Beneficial for students in the full IB Diploma Program, as well as for students interested in all 3 sciences who wish to “spread out” their learning so as not to be overwhelmed during the regular year.

MCF3M – Grade 11 Functions and Applications (college preparation)

- Offered to students entering Grade 11 next year.
- Prerequisite MPM2D/MFM2D.
- Particularly important for students who wish to further strengthen and develop their math skills **before** studying MCR3U in the regular Grade 11 year. MCR3U is a prerequisite course to all Grade 12 math courses needed for university admissions.
This course, MCF3M, will “bridge the gap” between MPM2D and MCR3U.

HZB3M – Grade 11 Philosophy (university/college preparation)

- Offered to students entering Grade 10, Grade 11, or Grade 12 next year.
- No prerequisite.
- Beneficial for students who wish to improve their critical thinking and writing skills. This course will also help full IB Diploma students prepare for the Theory of Knowledge requirement.

AMM3M – Grade 11 Music and Computers (university/college preparation)

- Offered to students entering Grade 10, Grade 11, or Grade 12 next year.
- Prerequisite AMU1O.
- Beneficial for students who wish to explore music through computer, MIDI, and synthesizer technology. Students will have the hands-on experience of using computers for creative exploration, composition, and performance.
