




#### Virtual Curriculum Night

#### School Uniform and Shoes - Grade I

With your help, our students are sure to have a sense of pride in wearing their school uniform properly throughout the year. By October 1st, the expectation is to have all students in their full school uniform and school shoes. Parents who are waiting for any uniform items may contact InSchoolwear and have the deliveries made to the school. Please ensure that uniform items are labelled with the student's name.

The approved school shoes are black leather dress shoes from Stride Right, Geox and Dr. Martens. Running shoes and sneakers are not permitted as part of the school uniform except at recess and Physical Education class.



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#### Anaphylactic Allergies

Within our school community there are a number of students who have a potentially life threatening allergy (anaphylaxis) to foods, predominantly to peanuts and nuts.

The risk to human life presented by anaphylaxis is severe and we feel the best way to reduce the risk of accidental exposure to students is to ask for the cooperation of the parents and guardians to avoid sending peanut butter or products with peanuts or nuts in the ingredients. The school is not designated as "nut free" or "allergen free". Your voluntary support is requested in reducing the risk for the students who have anaphylactic allergies. Your cooperation and understanding of this matter is appreciated.






#### **Administration of Medication**

We have put in place certain measures for administering medication for our students while at school. Parents are advised to contact the office to complete a Medical Form with all the instructions for administering the medication as well as their signature and date before leaving medication in school. If there is no written instructions and signed medical form, no medication will be administered to the student. Please contact the Office if you have any questions or concerns.



#### Safety Plans and Fire Drills

The safety of our students is paramount and TCPS, in conjunction with the Fire Department, has put in place revised fire and safety drills keeping in mind the physical distancing and all the Covid 19 protocols. Some of these measures are: maintaining social distancing, restricting access to school facilities and having designated areas for student pick up by designated individuals.
