IB World School The Mathematics Contest Centre prepares some of the top mathematics competitions in North America including the Canadian National Mathematica Centrum Contests.

Each April, Town Centre Private Schools participates in the Canadian National Mathematica Centrum Contests. Six elementary contests are held, one for each grade from 3 to 8 and TCPS students make us proud year after year. Not only did TCPS students excel at their grade level but a select number of students in grade 8 also wrote contests a grade higher than their current grade level, and four grade 8 students achieved a perfect score on the Grade 9 Newton Contest. Outstanding!

This year, Town Centre Private Schools competed along with 1,548 public and private Canadian schools. Below are the results:

In 2022, 32,640 students from across Canada wrote the grades 3 to 9 Mathematica Centrum Contests. All TCPS students in grades 3 to 8 wrote this year's contests and in addition to their grade contests, a select group of students in grade 8 also wrote the Grade 9 Newton Contest.

Town Centre Private Schools' top achieving students at each grade level were recognized for their achievements at the Academic Awards in June. In addition to the award winners, several students achieved outstanding results with only one or two errors on the tests, and 54 students made the Mathematica Honour Roll (see page 4) for attaining a grade of 80% or higher. Well done!
