EARLY RE-REGISTRATION DISCOUNT ENDS APRIL 1ST!

We sincerely appreciate all parents who have registered early, securing their child's place for the 2025-2026 school year.

For those choosing to pay the full year's tuition in a single installment, a 4% discount applies to full payments received by April 1, 2025. Parents opting for the monthly payment plan will receive a \$100 discount on the last month's deposit (June 2026). These discounts are available to all families who register before April 1, regardless of the selected payment method.
