**Dates:** June 30 – July 29, 2025



## REACH AHEAD SUMMER CREDIT COURSE 2025

Dear Parents and Guardians,

This summer, TCPS High School is excited to offer a *'reach ahead summer credit course'* where current grade 8 students can earn a high school credit, prior to entering grade 9 in September 2025! This fabulous opportunity will ease the transition from elementary into secondary schooling and will allow students to become familiar with secondary level assessments, evaluations, and structure. Students will gain a head start on credit accumulation, develop a variety of transferable learning and technology skills that will be useful in all secondary settings and beyond, while gaining self-confidence through the successful completion of their first high school course credit.

**Learning Strategies, GLS 10**, is a course that focuses on learning strategies to help students become better, more independent learners. Students will learn to develop and apply literacy and numeracy skills, personal management skills, and interpersonal and teamwork skills to improve their learning and achievement in school, the workplace, and the community. The course helps students build confidence and motivation to pursue opportunities for success in secondary school and beyond. *Particular emphasis will be placed on skills and tips to manage the transition to high school.*

This is an Ontario Ministry 1.0 credit course, which requires 110 instructional hours for successful completion. Successful completion of this course will be included on student transcripts.

This reach ahead summer credit course will begin on **June 30, 2025, and conclude on July 29, 2025**. Classes will run every day, from **Monday-Friday, 8:30am-2:00pm**, in-person at TCPS. An online learning option will not be available. Before/after school supervision will not be available.

The cost to TCPS students registered for our Grade 9 program is \$950.00.

Should you be interested in registering for this reach ahead summer credit course, please register using the link above. Consideration will be given to all applicants by Mr. Lamanna, our Elementary School Principal, and Ms. Leepy Hajra, our High School Principal. These courses require sufficient enrolment to run and are therefore not guaranteed at this time. Once student responses are received, a follow-up communication will be made to confirm if this course will be offered.
